| <b>Office Clerk</b>                 | Perform various administrative and clerical tasks to support various daily operations.  | <b>\$17.00 per hour</b> |
| <b>Office Operations Supervisor</b> | Assist in the management of office functions and day-to-day activities.   | <b>\$21.50 per hour</b> |
| <b>Census Field Supervisor</b>      | Conduct field work to support and conduct on-the-job training for census takers and/ or to follow-up in situations where census takers have confronted issues, such as not gaining entry to restricted areas.   | <b>\$23.00 per hour</b> |
| <b>Enumerators</b>                  | Some field positions require employees to work during the day to locate addresses on buildings. Other field positions require interviewing the public, so employees must be able to work when people are usually at home, such as in the evening and on weekends. | <b>\$21.00 per hour</b> |
